Brick Math Grades 3 – 4 Accommodations and Modifications

Brick Math is designed to reach tactile, visual, and auditory learners with its very nature. The specific modifications below are for specific populations of students in need of assistance beyond general learning style needs. *Modifications* refer to changes in the content or lesson that can be made for specific learners. *Accommodations* refer to changes in the environment or actual materials used to provide access to the learning. The charts below outline modifications and accommodations that can be accessed to increase the learner's ability to successfully learn the content and to engage with the materials.

- 3) The use of an iPad or tech device with photo capability can be used to take pictures of brick models built instead of drawing the models for students who have dexterity needs.
